The main aim of conducting this web talk was to learn the concepts of Chromatography, its types and their uses in various fields.

On this occasion Dr. Dalima Parwani, Principal said in her welcome note that Chromatography is widely used for qualitative and quantitative analysis of a large number of compounds. This technique was basically developed in 19th Century to separate plant pigments.

The Resource Person was Ms. Shazia Khan, HOD, Dept. of Biotechnology, SHGC Bhopal. She focused on Chromatography, literally colour writing was first employed by Mikhail Tsvet in 1900. She added that Chromatography is a process used for identifying and separating individual components from mixtures of substances. This technique has many applications in the field of Biochemistry, Analytical Chemistry, Petro Chemical, Environmental Monitoring, Criminal Forensic and Pharmacokinetics & it has been widely employed in industries that involve large scale separation and purification of compounds. She also added that there are different types of Chromatography including gas-liquid, paper, HPLC, TLC, Gel permeation and ion exchange chromatography. Nearly 80 students from various colleges were benefitted by this enriching web talk.

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

Some of the most important electrophilic aromatic substitution are aromatic nitration, aromatic halogenation, aromatic sulphonation, alkylation and acylation Friedel-Crafts reaction e.t.c. She stressed on the mechanism of organic electrophilic substitution reaction also.

Web Talk on How to Write Research Paper


A Stepwise Approach


She gave importance to tips for managing Covid-19, wear masks (double), keep yourself hydrated take fever medicines, avoid touching nose and eyes in public places.




Dr. Dalima Parwani, Principal, shared that in the crisis of Pandemic too the students must gain knowledge of subject along with employment opportunities.


