Seven Days NSS Camp Inaugurated

Seven Days NSS Camp organized

Sant Hirdaram Girls College in Bhopal organized a Seven-Day National Service Scheme (NSS) Camp from March 1st to March 7th at adopted village Mugaliya Haat near Prerana Kiran Higher Secondary School. Addressing the Concluding ceremony, Shri Hero Gyanchandani, Chairman of Sant Hirdaram Group and Director of Shaheed Hemu Kalani Educational Society, expressed that there is a parallel between Sant Ji's vision and the goals of NSS. He also said that it is a means to foster service spirit among students.



The main objective of the NSS is to provide young students with experiential learning in developing their personalities through community service. The ideal statement of the NSS is "Not Me but you," emphasizing the welfare of others before oneself. Sant Shiromani Hirdaram Ji Sahib's guidance and the continuous efforts of Sant Hirdaram Girls College, under the leadership of their successor revered Siddh Bhau Ji, reflect this spirit.

In alignment with this philosophy, the Seven-Day NSS Camp aims to make students understand rural environments and create awareness among them about various government schemes and urban settings. In this context, students of Sant Hirdaram Girls College actively engaged with the rural community during the seven-day camp, spreading awareness about the Nikshay Yojana and free treatment for hepatitis in government hospitals. Also, during village visit, every villager was effectively educated about the essential nature of the voting process for democracy.

Various intellectual sessions were conducted during the camp, including a discussion on "Energy Conservation and Energy Production from Non-Conventional Energy Sources" by Shri Amit Khare, Joint Director of the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission. He not only provided information about consumer rights but also made rural communities aware of these rights. Shri Khare explained in detail the government system for resolving complaints related to monopoly industries.

Prof. Babita Goswami from the Department of Nutrition discussed the importance of food in a healthy lifestyle. Shri Anil Khare, an invited guest from Jeevan Jyoti Charitable Trust, taught students to make bags from jeans and seed balls. These activities are crucial for environmental conservation. 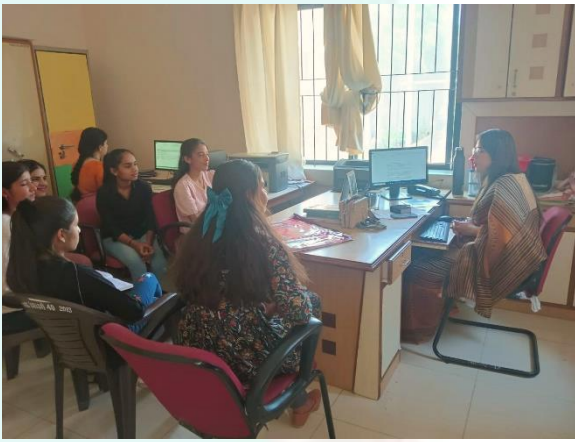

Home Visits, Career Counselling and Admissions

Faculties introduced them to various courses of science, commerce and Computer Science as the basics and then they explained them the sea of opportunities in the outer world.
