On 18.01.2025, Saturday, Students of Commerce Department of Sant Hirdaram Girls College, Bhopal visited Jagdishpur. Jagdishpur is a panchayat village in Bhopal district of Madhya Pradesh, India. It is located in Huzur Tehsil and Phanda Block. Earlier known as Islamnagar Jagdishpur was formerly a fortified city, which was the capital of the Bhopal state for some time. The ruins of the palaces built by Bhopal's founder Dost Mohammad Khan are still present at this place. Many members of the royal family of Bhopal were born in Islamnagar. In February 2023, the Madhya Pradesh government officially changed the name of the village to Jagdishpur, which is its original name. It was founded by local Rajput chieftains. The architecture and construction techniques of the palaces here introduce us to the rich knowledge tradition of India. History is witness that Bhopal's female ruler Sikander Begum assumed power as regent from here. However, in 1860 Sikander Begum was recognized by the British as the ruler of Bhopal. After her death in 1868, her daughter Shah Jahan took over as the Begum of Bhopal. Her achievements as a female ruler were praiseworthy. This visit of the students of a women institution was an inspiration to empower them and make continuous progress.
