Launch Program of CPBFI in Sant Hirdaram Girls College





Motivational Oration by Sagar Dodeja organized at Sant Hirdaram Girls College



Pidilite Workshop organized by Dept. of Education




NCC Cadet Captain Harshita Mishra Honored

Banking Classes Successfully Conducted



Guest Lecture on Protein Biosynthesis

Zoology Department of College conducted online guest lecture on Protein Biosynthesis on 25th February, 2021. The resource person was Dr. Ashish Jain, Asst. Prof., Botany, Govt. Nehru PG College, Deori, Sagar, MP. He explained Protein Synthesis as the process where all cells use to make protein which are responsible for cell structure and function. He also focused on transcription, translation, DNA, Genetic Code, RNA, Ribosome etc. Protein Structure based method will continue to contribute to the discovery and development of anti-infective compounds and will remain and important tool in the arsenal of drug discovery scientist, He suggested that protein can be used as a drug for disorders such as diabetes, cancer and arthritis. The deficiency of proteins causes malnutrition and therefore it is a vital nutrient to be supplemented in the food.

Dr. Dalima Parwani, Principal shared that awareness towards protein deficiency is necessary for healthy and fit body. In the daily routine one must ensure proper intake of protein rich diet.


