New Year Celebration & Resolution Competition

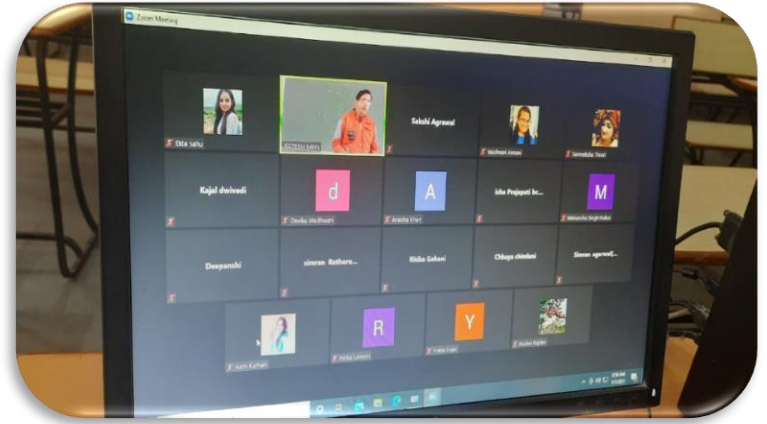

The key points covered in the webinar are as below:

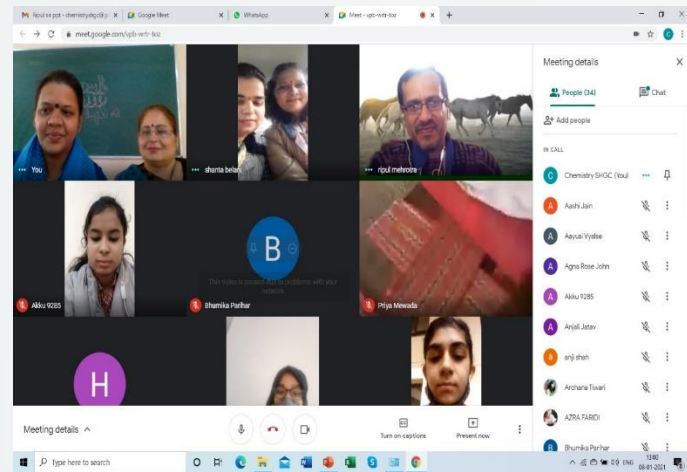
- Much of the success or failure of a lecture depends on the learnings.

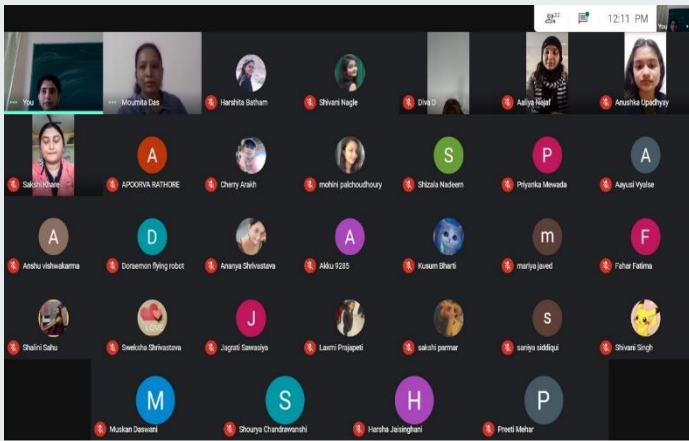

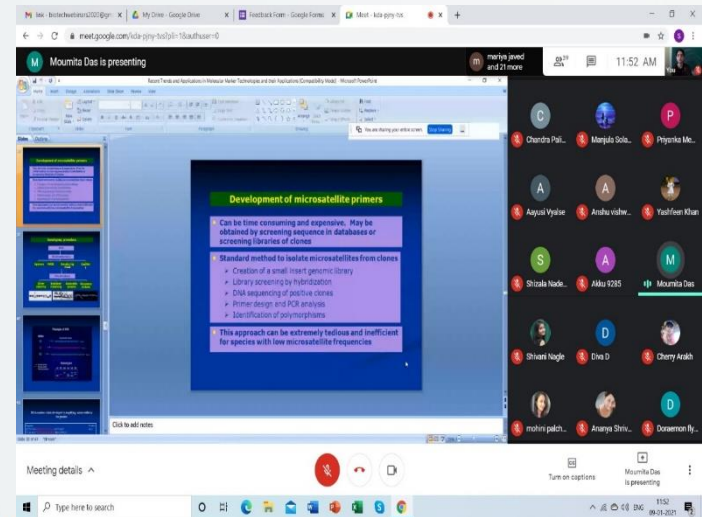


Saturday, 9th January, 2021

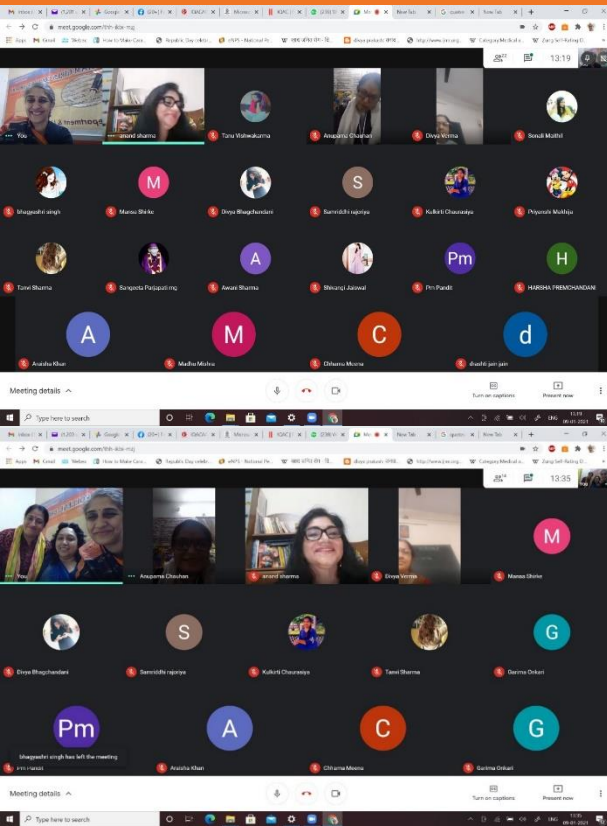


Saturday, 9th January, 2021

Celebration of National Youth Day on Birth Anniversary of Swami Vivekananda

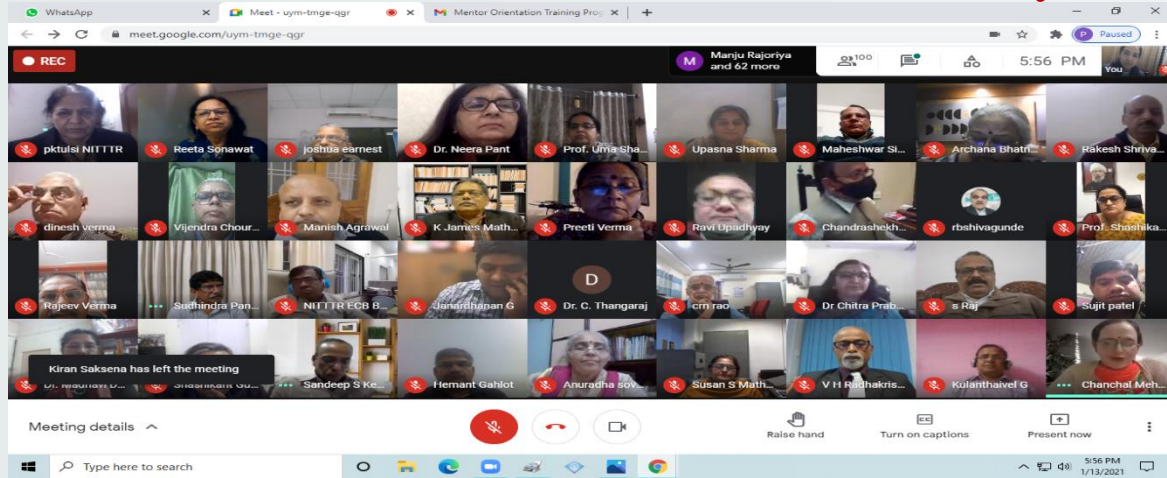

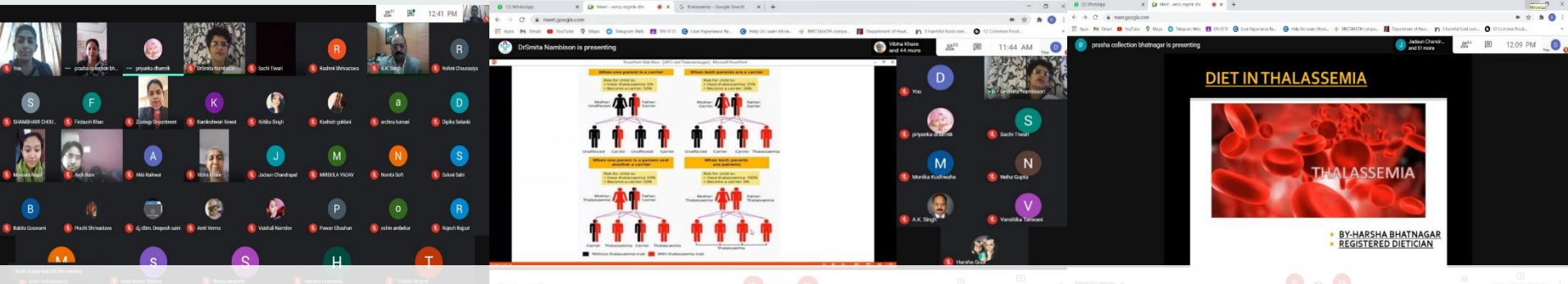
**Awareness Workshop on NIRF India Rankings -2021

The agenda for making the members of IQAC to attend this workshop was to bring an awareness to gain knowledge about the procedure and critical insights of NIRF in order to apply for ranking in the near future.

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Webinar on “Thalassemia” organized by Department of Zoology and F&N



On 19th January 2021, Department of Zoology & Food & Nutrition of Sant Hirdaram Girls College, Bhopal organized a Webinar on the relevant topic “Thalassemia”. The Guest speakers for the session were **Dr. Smita Nambison** & **Ms. Harsha Bhatnagar**. Around eighty- five participants registered for the same. **Dr. Smita Nambison**, Registered Dietician & Inventor of Monogenic Disorder Forecast Card shared in her views that Thalassemia is a inherited blood- disorder in which the body makes an abnormal form of haemoglobin. The disorder results in excessive destruction of red blood cells, which leads to Anaemia. She told us in detail about Thalassemia awareness program like Optimal treatment, Career Screening, Genetic Counselling & Genetic Inheritance Pattern Counselling Identification Card (GIPCI Card), which is very useful in inherited disorders like Thalassemia, Sickle -cell Anaemia, Haemophilia, Cystic fibrosis, Fragile Syndrome & Huntington’s disease and this card was prepared & patented by her.

Ms. Harsha Bhatnagar, Registered Dietician & Assistant Professor, Department of Food & Nutrition shared her views on dietary management in Thalassemia disease. She briefly explained the importance of therapeutic nutritional care in this disease & advised to avoid iron intake & take tea/ coffee after every meal. She also explained in detail about “Chelation Therapy” & chelating agents in diet & advised to increase the intake of Vitamin C in the diet for patients infected from this. The Webinar was very enlightening & intrusive.

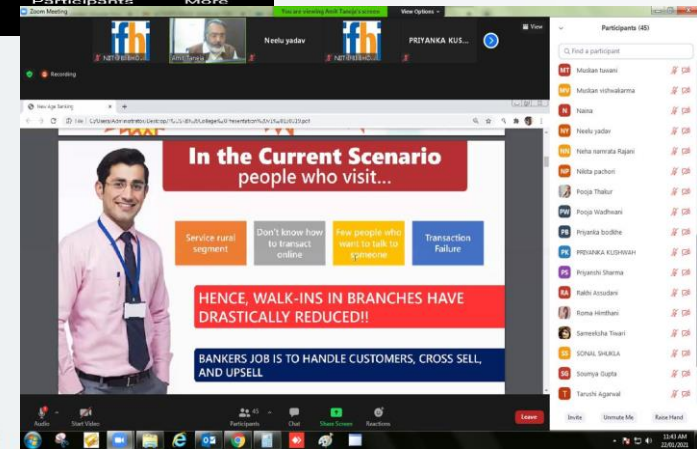
The overall session was very thought provoking, informative & provided the participants with enormous knowledge on various aspects of AI Technology.
