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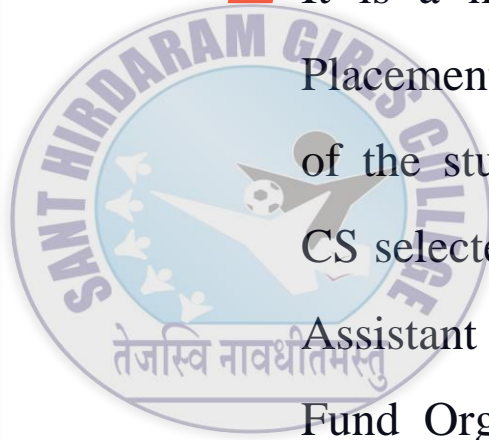

Thursday, 19th & 20th March, 2021

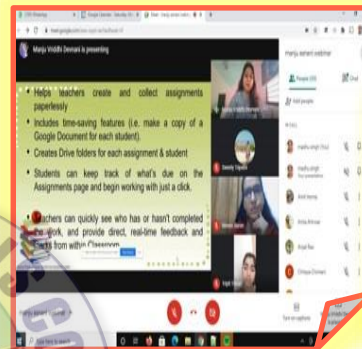

Webinar on "The role of women in Indian freedom struggle"

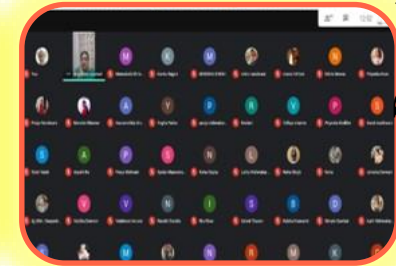
Saturday, 20th March, 2021

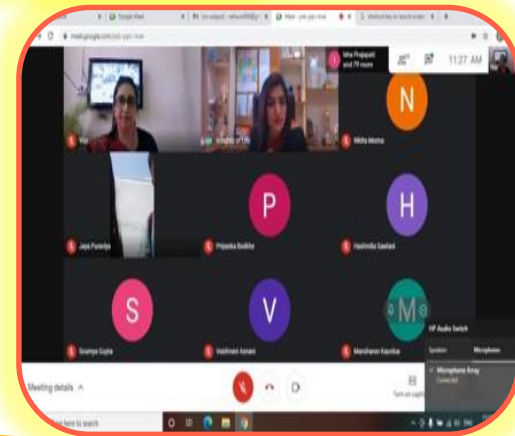
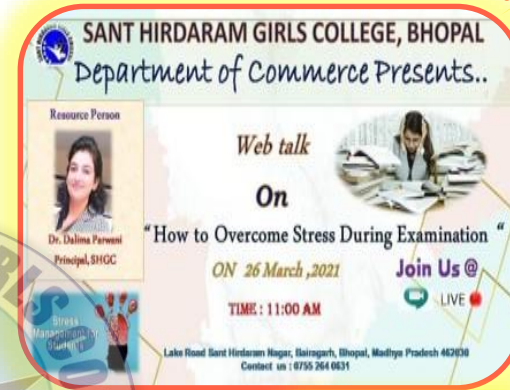
Webtalk on “How to Overcome Stress During Examination”

Web Talk on "Holi: Festival of colours - Duties and Challenges

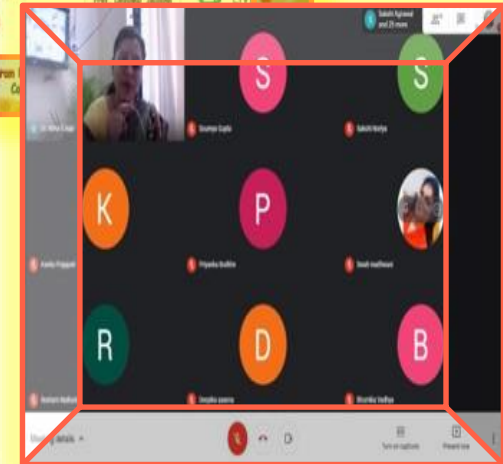
Saturday, 27th March, 2021

The benefits and opportunities of Digital Marketing were highlighted

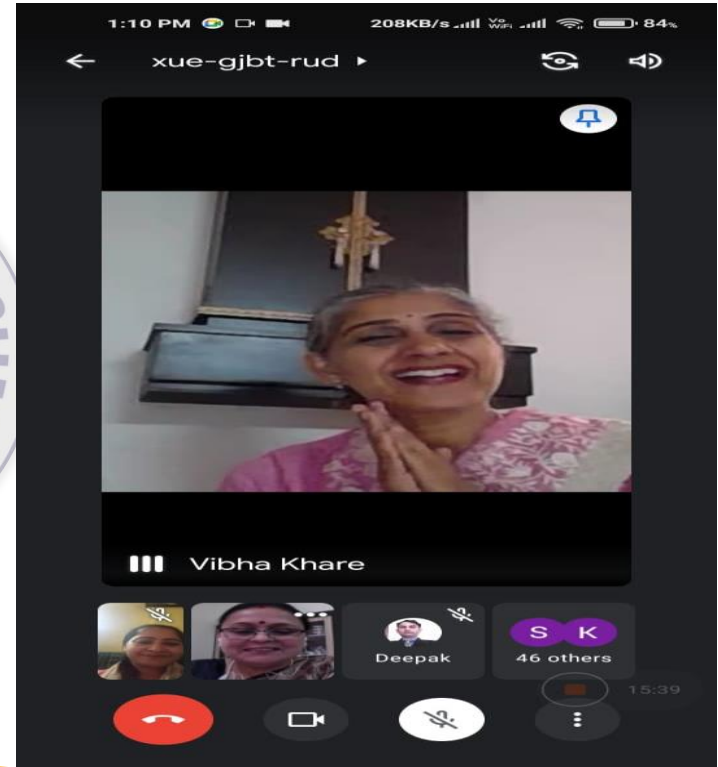
