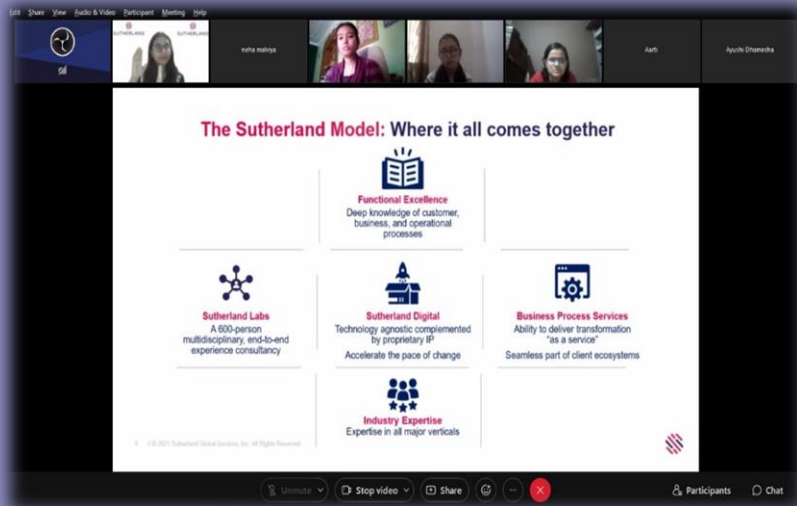

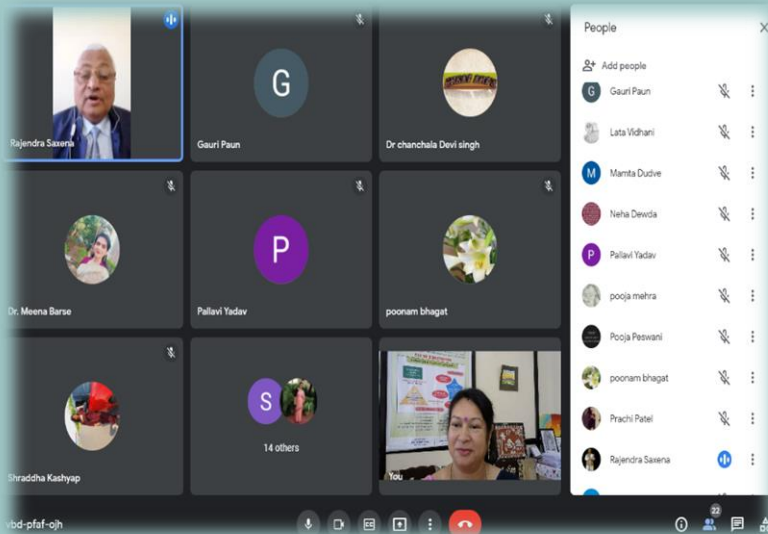

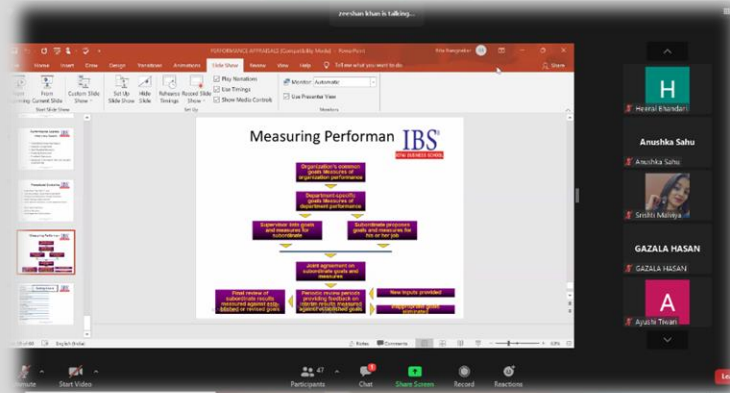


CONVOCATION CEREMONY HELD IN RABINDRANATH TAGORE UNIVERSITY

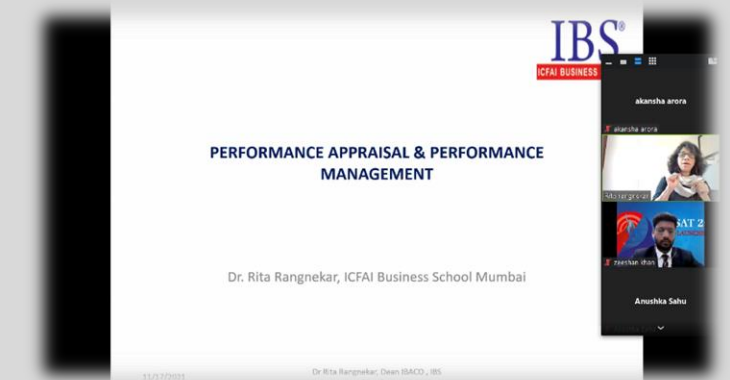

GUEST LECTURE ON PERFORMANCE APPRAISAL



- Department of Commerce, SHGC in association with ICFAI Business School, Hyderabad had organized a guest lecture on “PERFORMANCE APPRAISAL” on 17/11/2021. The key note speaker for the session was Dr. Rita Rangnekar, Dean- Institution Building, ICFAI Business school, Mumbai. This lecture was exclusively organized for the students of B.Com. (H) III Year, BBA II Year and BBA III Year students who have opted for HR as their specialization. Around 70 students had filled the registration form prior to the lecture and had attended the same. Dr. Rita addressed the students by asking a simple question i.e. how would you appraise anyone’s performance? She further moved with the explanation and discussed the features, process and methods of performance appraisal and performance management. She said that this employee- centric performance management can also be referred to as a performance review, performance evaluation, merit rating as well as career development discussion. Under the methods of performance appraisal 5 of them were discussed in detail i.e. self-evaluation, 360-degree appraisal system, graphic rating scale, checklists and essay method. This process is carried out to identify the inherent qualities of an employee and the abilities and level of competency of an employee for their future growth. This practice even helps the organizations to place the right employee for the right kind of job. The students actively participated in the question answer round which took place at the end of the session. Dr. Rita closed the discussion with a quote stating “Teams are the main building blocks of organizations and HR practices as performance management should become more team focused.” Students are looking forward for such sessions in future as well.

FOUNDATION DAY OF SHKES CELEBRATED



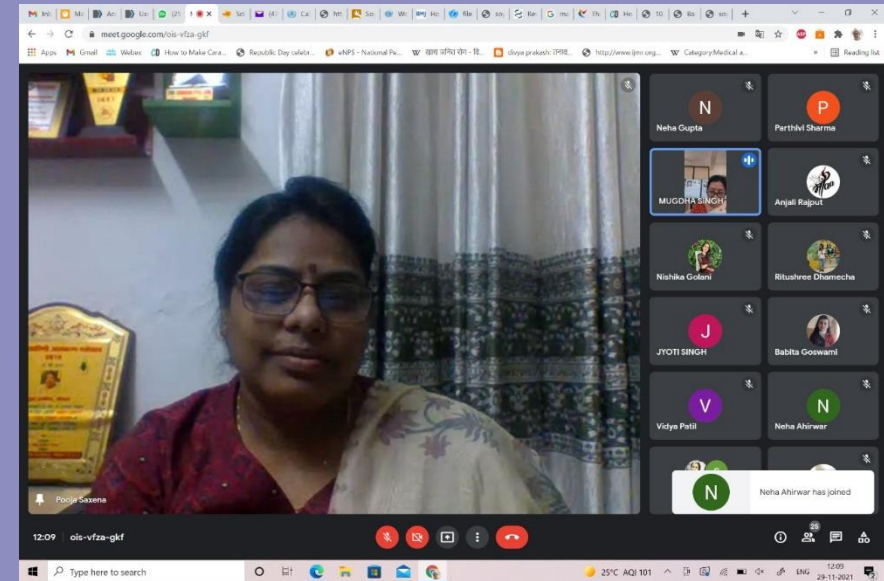
