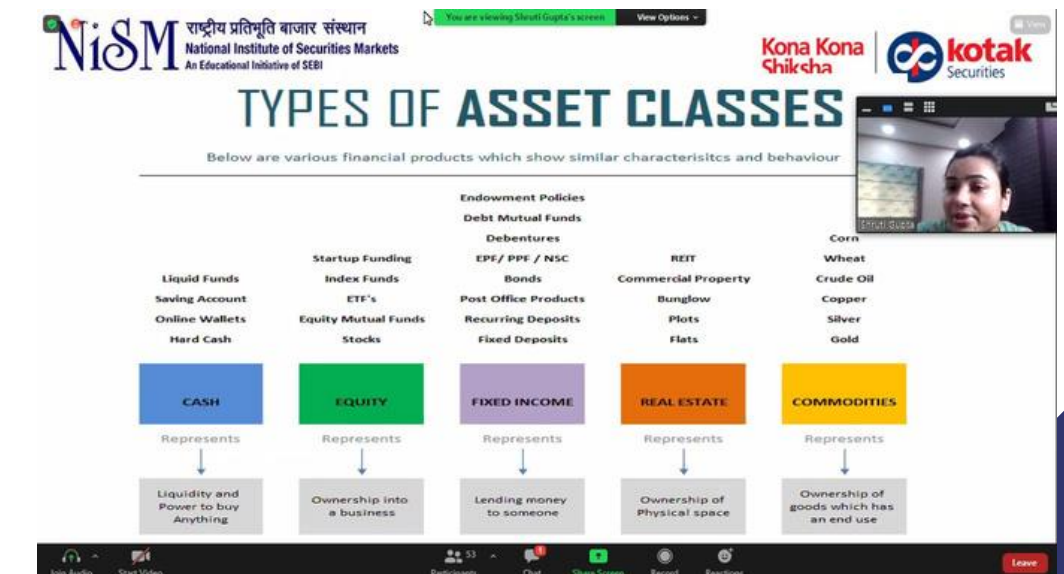
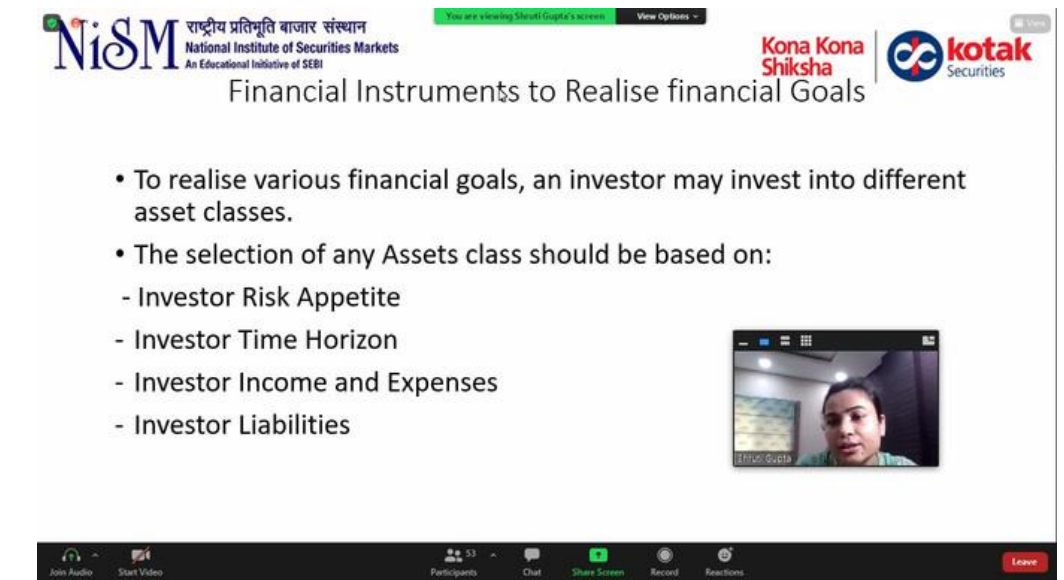
Tuesday to Friday, 24th August to 3rd September, 2021

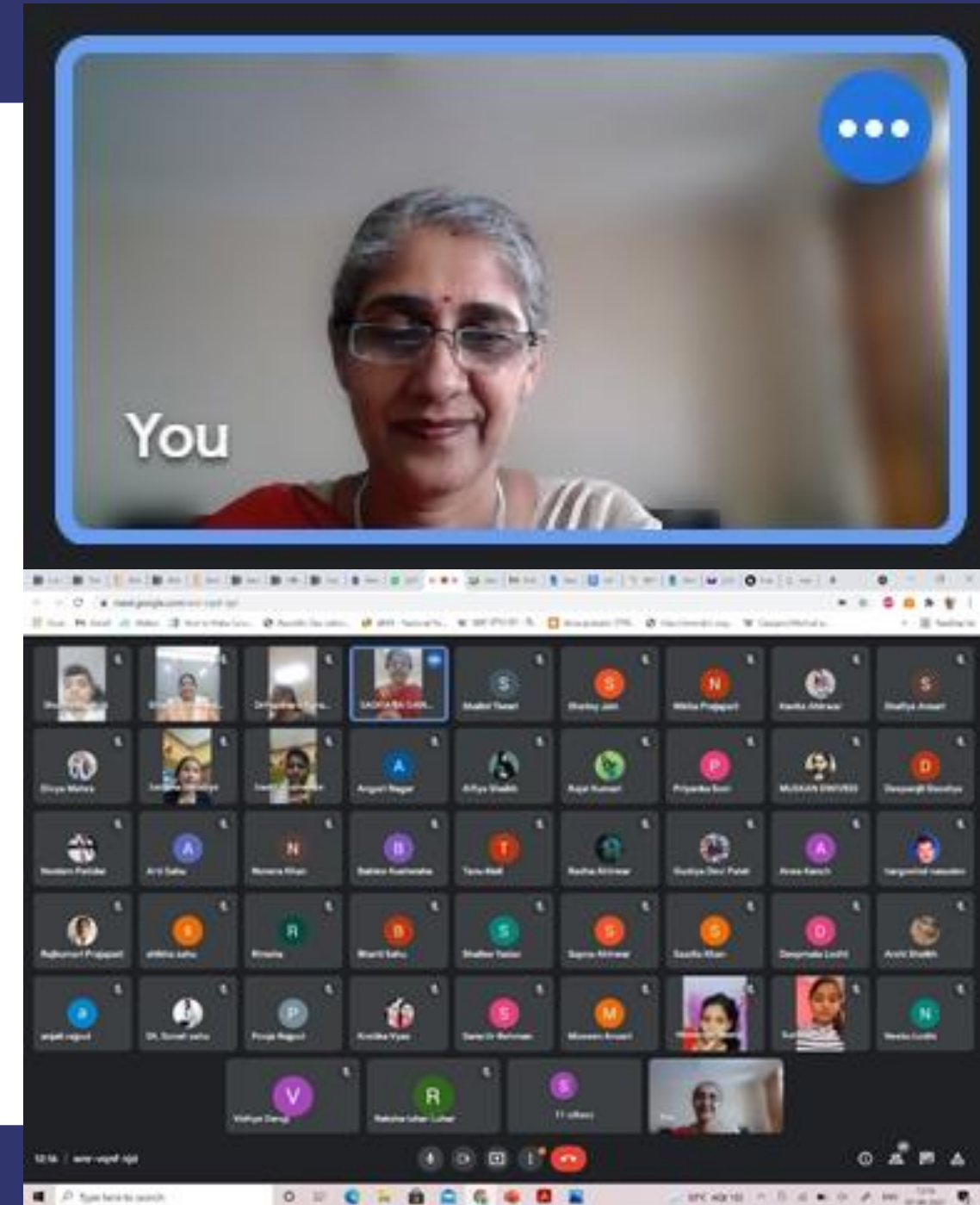
