The students enjoyed throughout the session and gained knowledge about how to be happy, spread happiness around and importance of happiness to lead a successful life.








# Webinar on National Voter's Day



# Republic Day Observed




#### Academic Audit, 2021-22

#### Webinar on Subhash Chandra Bose






On 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2022, Saturday, with the blessings of Paramhans Sant Shiromani Hirdaram Sahibji, inspiration, motivation and guidance of Shradhey Siddh Bhauji, a special webinar to commemorate 125<sup>th</sup> Birth Anniversary of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose was organized by the Department of Language under the initiative of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava. The Resource Person was Dr. Naveen Gideon, Prof. & Head, Dept. of History, Govt. Autonomous Girls PG College of Excellence, Sagar.

Dr. Dalima Parwani, Principal expressed her gratitude towards distinguished speaker and said that Netaji was one of the greatest Indian Statesman who convinced contemporary International Leaders to support his campaign for an Independent India.

The subject expert Dr. Naveen Gideon briefed that Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose was a legendary freedom fighter who not only challenged the British colonial rule but also worked towards actualizing the vision of complete independence of undivided India. He highlighted that Netaji was a visionary leader who built several international alliances to boost the nation's freedom struggle, revived the Indian National Army and formulated the provisional Government of Azad Hind in 1943. He learnt the qualities of saintliness from his father and compassion from his mother. The students must learn positive and good qualities from their parents. He added that Mahatma Gandhi was conferred the title of the Father of the Nation by Subhash Chandra Bose on 4<sup>th</sup> June, 1944.
