


The Main aim of conducting this Webinar was to help students to assess themselves and to understand their area of interest to choose a career.

Webinar on Haemoglobin Metabolism







Thursday, 3rd June, 2021

On 3rd June, Thursday, A Webinar on **Haemoglobin Metabolism** was organized by Department of Clinical Nutrition & Dietetics of Sant Hirdaram Girls College, Bhopal. The Department was established in the year 2006 since then the students of our institution are getting merit positions in Barkatullah University. The students are highly placed which is the added feather in the cap of the Department. heeynote Speaker was Ms. Harsha Bhatnagar who is the registered dietitian.

She explained that haemoglobin, abbreviated Hb, is the iron-containing oxygen transport metalloprotein in the RBC of almost all vertebrates. Haemoglobin in blood carries oxygen from the lungs to the rest of the body. There it releases the oxygen to permit aerobic respiration to provide energy to power the functions of the organism in the process called metabolism. She further elaborated that a healthy individual has 12 to 20 grams of haemoglobin in every 100 ml of blood. She briefly explained about the common causes of low haemoglobin which include loss of blood, nutritional deficiency, bone marrow problems, chemotherapy, kidney failure or abnormal haemoglobin.

Prof. Vibha Khare, HOD, Clinical Nutrition & Dietetics explained that in this pandemic when people are fighting with hypoxia (lack of oxygen) understanding of haemoglobin metabolism will increase their insight on this issue. In her address she told that the 6 students of Clinical Nutrition & Dietetics Department served in a village to eradicate SAM (Severe Acute Malnutrition) in collaboration with Kunjal Welfare Society.

Webinar on Mental Well-being: Acceptance and Commitment






Webinar on Application of Differential Equation in Real World Life






Workshop Organized by NCC & NSS Unit



The speaker believed that contributing small efforts will make a big difference. He explained the function of psychological support committee, whose prime objective is to promote psychological well-being of affected people.






Wednesday, 16th June, 2021







