Saturday, 4th December, 2021

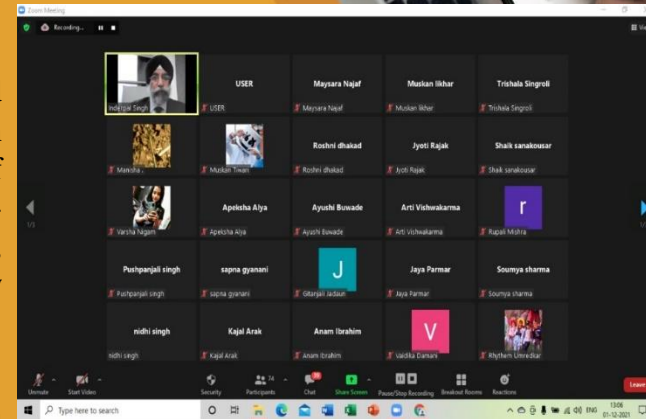
Workshop on Personality Development

Shri Veer Singh Rajput, Modeller, explained that cultural heritage reflects the social, economic and political status of that period and hence conservation is necessary to conserve cultural heritage for the future. He elaborated the proper documentation of monuments and highlighted various important archaeological monuments of historical importance periodically.

During the visit, the students learnt various procedures & methods adopted to safeguard and protect historical monuments especially chemical conservation of state protected monuments and artifacts which are on display and kept in the museums. The outstanding art pieces & rare antiquities of Madhya Pradesh were displayed in eye-catching manner. All the students had a great learning from galleries comprised of various subjects included thematic gallery, pre-history & fossils, excavated materials, metal images, inscriptions, sculptures, royal collections, textiles, freedom movement, postal stamps, autographs, manuscripts, paintings, coins, weapons, documents of medieval age and rare musical instruments.



Saturday, 11th December, 2021

Workshop on Vedic Mathematics



On 11th December, 2021, Saturday, five days' workshop on Vedic Mathematics concluded which was organized by the Department of Mathematics. The Resource person was Dr. Sandeep Kumar Malhotra, associate Professor, Department of Mathematics, Govt. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee College, Bhopal. Dr. Varsha Mandwariya, Convener of the Workshop briefed about the schedule of the workshop and said that the aim of organizing this workshop was to appraise the students regarding the tricks they could employ to make their calculation faster, easier and precisely.

Dr. Dalima Parwani, Principal said that Vedic Mathematics offers an intuitive and interesting way to teach and learn mathematics. She added that in this era when interest in mathematics is flagging, a new approach is always welcome which will be beneficial to the students.

On the inaugural day, 7th December, 2021 Dr. Sandeep Kumar Malhotra, the Subject Expert shared the brilliance of Vedic Mathematics and taught new tricks to the students to calculate faster and with accuracy. He gave numerous examples and in hand practice to grasp the tricks spontaneously. This system helps in checking the independent set of methods which can be useful in cross-checking the answers that reduces the possibility of doing careless mistakes while solving the problems. During the workshop the faculties of mathematics ensured that the participants acquaint themselves with the magic of Vedic Mathematics and learn sutras that will help solve complex mathematical problems with ease. They talked about the system in Vedic Mathematics which is in the form of sutras or formulae discovered by Indian mathematician, Jagadguru Shri Barathi Krishna Tirthaji. It consists of 16 sutras and 13 sub-sutras. The sutras provide a fresh insight into our number system.

On 11th December, 2021 on the concluding day also the subject expert Dr. Sandeep Kumar Malhotra said that Vedic Mathematics is useful in developing the creativity and intelligence by improvising the clarity in mind. He further added that with the help of Vedic Mathematics, one can perform the calculation 10 to 15 times faster than the conventional methods.

The students thoroughly enjoyed the techniques of fast calculations through series of fun activities and students showed keen interest and participated in the workshop with zeal and enthusiasm.

Educational Visit to Narmada Milk and Product Ltd.

On 13th December, 2021, Monday, Department of Microbiology and Biotechnology organized one day study visit to Narmada Milk and Product Ltd. 30 students and two faculty members visited Narmada Milk and Product Ltd. The introductory lecture was given by Dr. Ramakant Sharma about the dairy and different zone of laboratory.

Students visited the quality control lab in which they learnt various qualitative and quantitative tests of assessing the adulterants as well as the nutrients of different milk products of this plant. By this visit students are able to understand the process of pasteurization microbiological aspects of food production especially milk.

Joy of Giving Campaign by NSS Unit

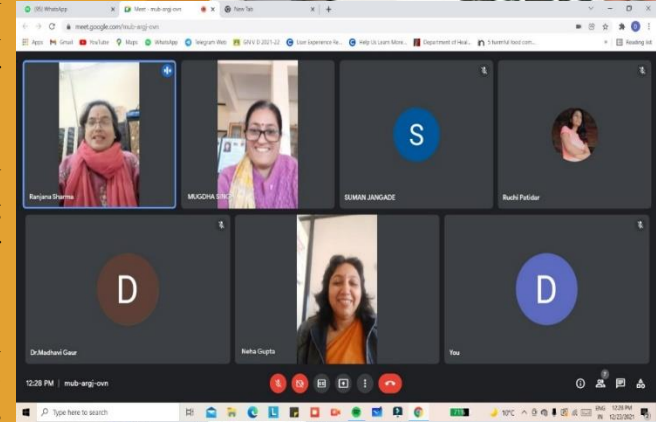

During the workshop, the faculties trained the students to form fixative with formalin technique. They briefed about the basic museum techniques which are reception, preparation, fixation, colour restoration, preservation, mounting, presentation etc. Students under the guidance of teachers filled the jar and prepared the specimen individually. The workshop was enriching and 20 students participated actively and learned the concepts.

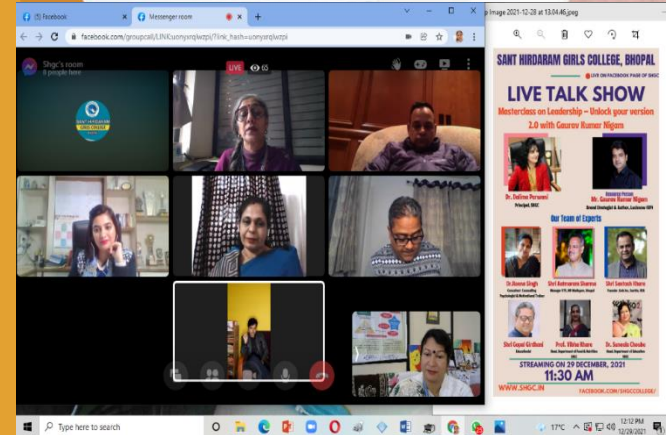
Mr. Aatmaram Sharma said that leader should possess knowledge, humbleness, eligibility, happiness and one must choose hardest challenges in life.
