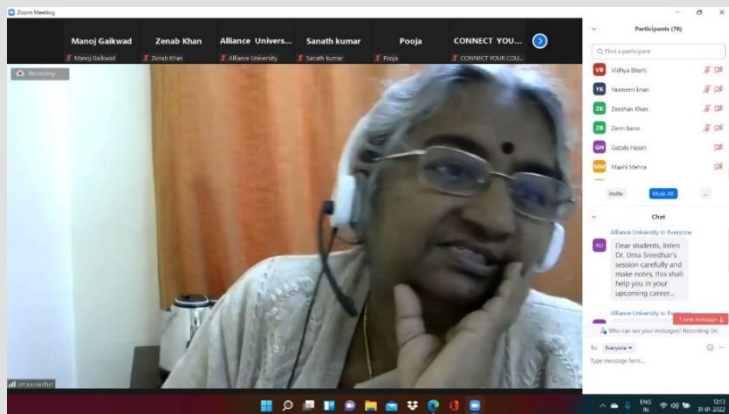
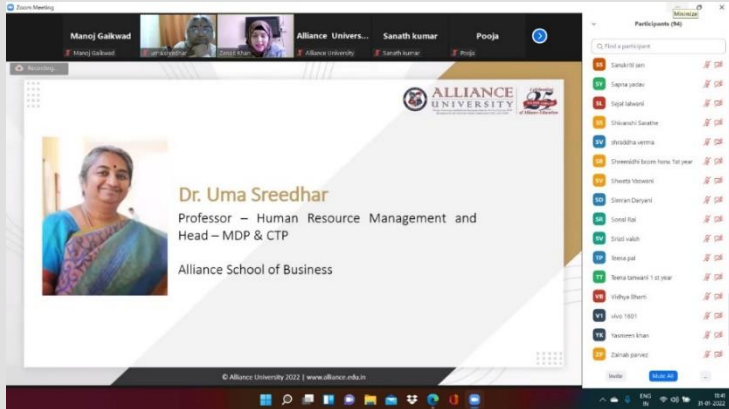
Tuesday, 1st February 2022

Web Talk on Campus to Corporate

On 1st February 2022, Tuesday, Department of Commerce in collaboration with Alliance University, Bengaluru organized a web talk on Campus to Corporate. The main aim of organizing this web talk was to provide an insight to students for transition from their campus life to the corporate world. The chief speaker was Dr. Uma Sreedhar, Professor-HRM, Head MDP & CTP Alliance University, Bengaluru.

She added that overall grooming is important where students understand the importance of timelines, their endurance power, tech-savvy, the ability to adapt and adjust in their environment. The web talk concluded by a questionnaire round where student's queries were resolved successfully. Around 80 students actively participated in the program.

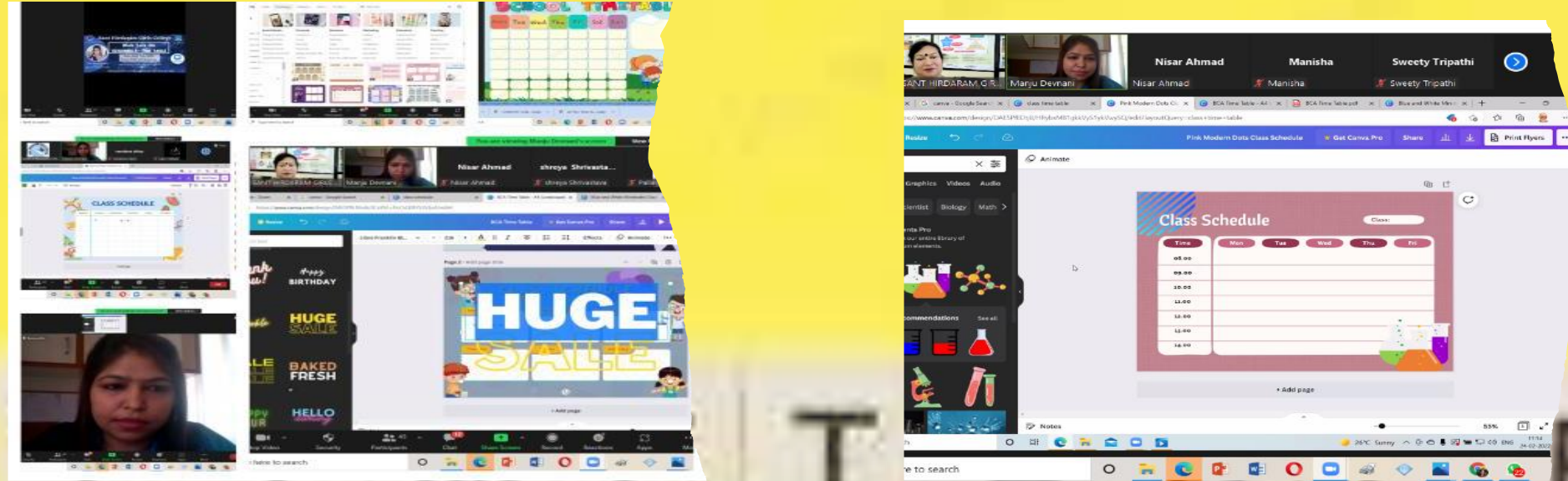
Field Visit to agricultural Farm

Web Talk on Designing e-Time Table



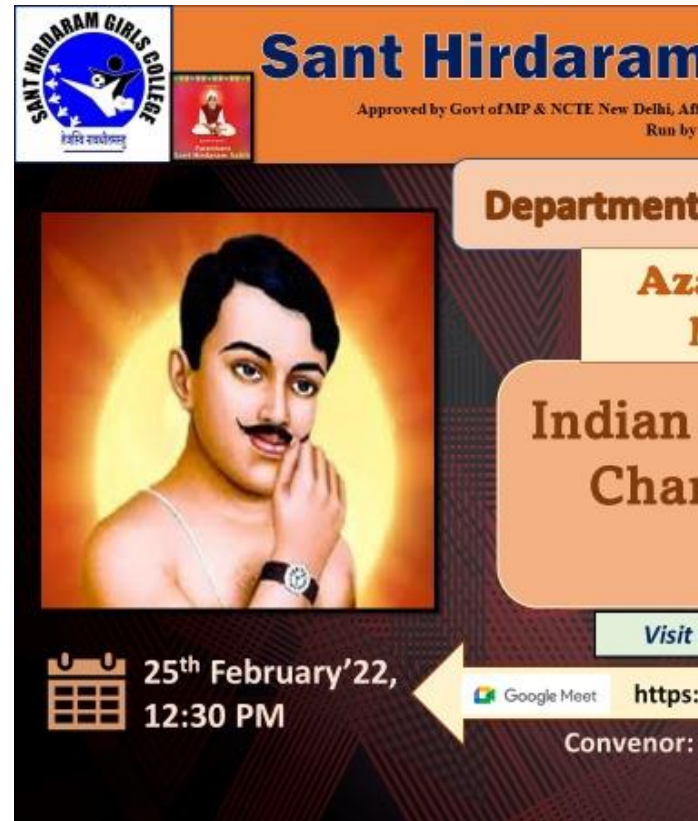
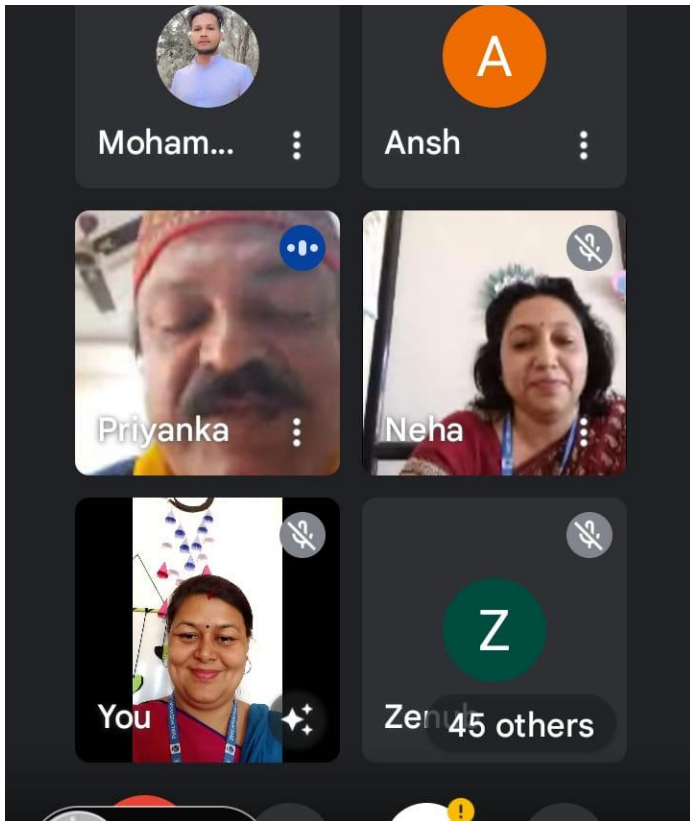

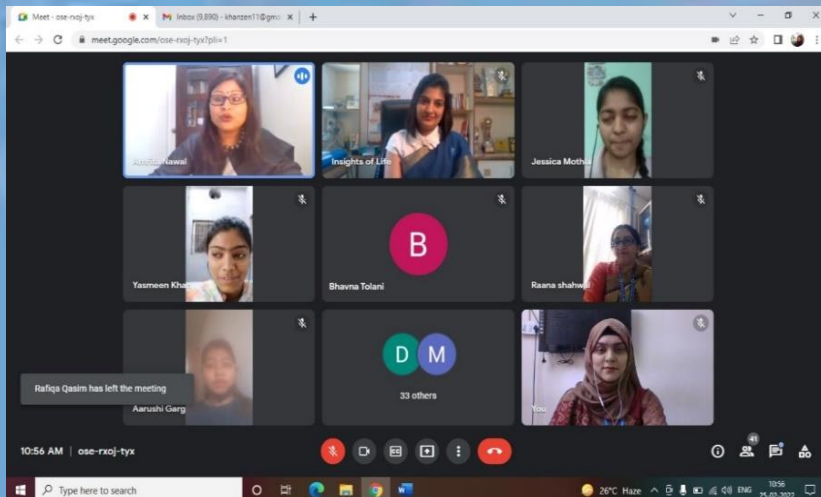
Launch Program of CPBFI

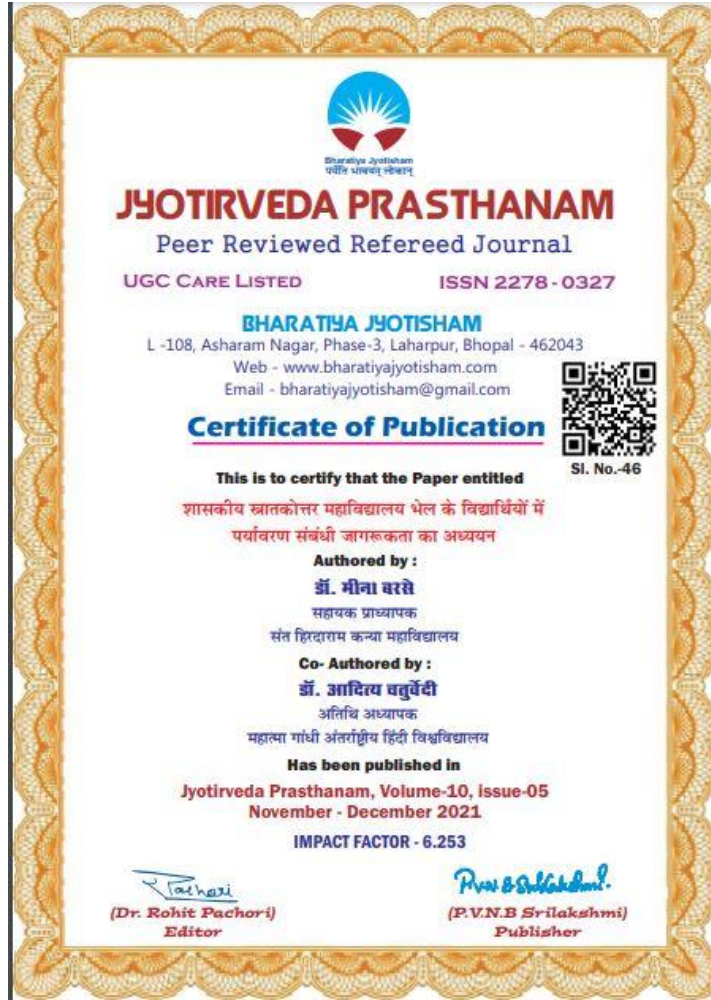

Evaluation Of DPPH Free Radical Scavenging Activity Of Barleria Prionitis

ABSTRACT:-

A comparison study of the antioxidative activities was conducted *in vitro* on the different extracts of Barleria Prionitis. Leaves were extracted by soxhlet extraction method with ethanol, methanol, and chloroform, respectively. For evaluation of antioxidant activity Diphenyl picryl hydrazyl (DPPH) method was used for these extracts. The results of antioxidative study of Barleria prionitis extracts from different solvents with reference to ascorbic acid presented different free radical scavenging activities: methanol>ethanol> chloroform. Maximum activity was shown by methanolic extract that is 278.04 ± 0.55 .

Keywords :- Antioxidant activity, DPPH, free radical scavenging activities.

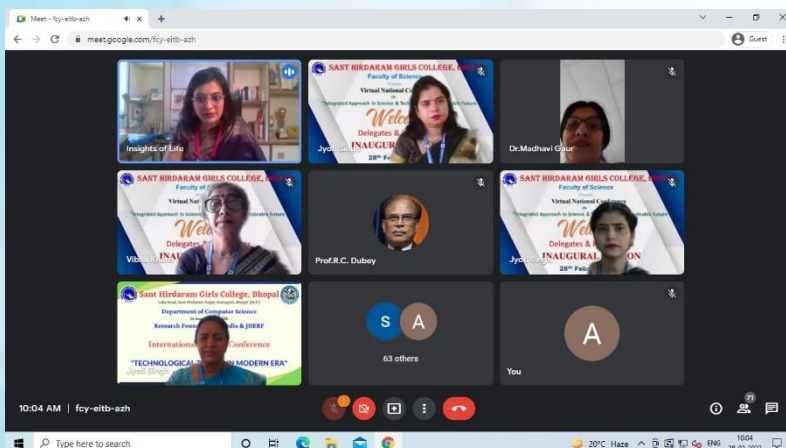
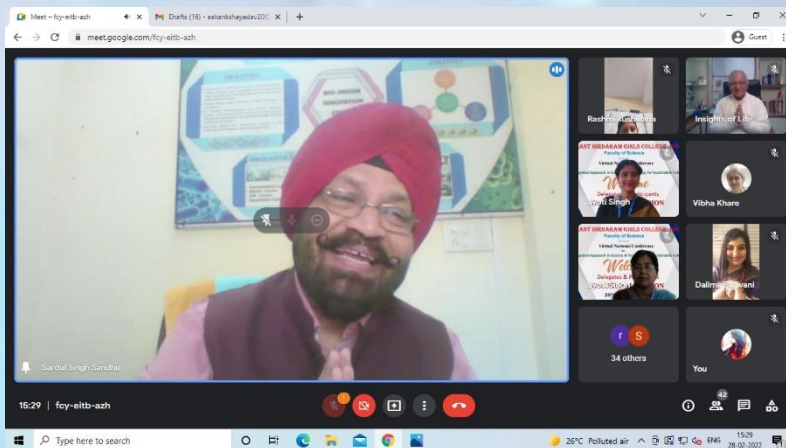
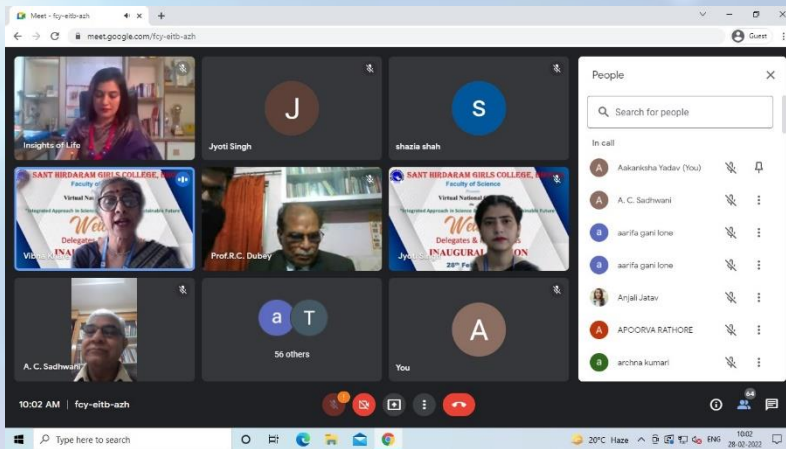
