SHGC organized Intercollegiate Certificate Course cum Training on Plant Tissue Culture Techniques



The Department of Biotechnology, Sant Hirdaram Girls College, Bhopal, in collaboration with the Madhya Pradesh Council of Science & Technology MPCST, Bhopal, successfully organized an Intercollegiate Certificate Course cum Training on Plant Tissue Culture Techniques from 19th January 2026 to 30th January 2026. The program was coordinated by Dr. Shazia Khan, Head, Department of Biotechnology.

The objective of the course was to provide students with strong theoretical foundations along with extensive practical exposure to plant tissue culture techniques. The workshop emphasized hands-on training, enabling participants from different colleges to develop essential laboratory skills.

The training program was conducted under the expert guidance of Mr. Shivanshu Shukla, Assistant Professor, Department of Biotechnology, RKDF University, who served as the resource person for the program. His expertise and hands-on approach provided students with valuable exposure to both theoretical and applied aspects of plant tissue culture.

The major highlights included aseptic techniques and media preparation, explant selection, inoculation, and micropropagation techniques. Advanced concepts such as callus induction, organogenesis, the role of plant growth regulators, and the applications of plant tissue culture in agriculture, horticulture, conservation, and biotechnology industries were also covered.

The intercollegiate certificate course cum training proved to be highly beneficial in enhancing students technical competence, scientific understanding, and practical confidence. The college management appreciated the efforts of the Department of Biotechnology and the course coordinator for successfully conducting the program, and encouraged the organization of more such skill-oriented and research-based initiatives in the future.
