Following the declaration of examination results and the opening of the E-Pravesh and DTE portals, the college team promptly intensified its outreach activities through personalized home visits and counselling sessions.



These visits were conducted to provide detailed information regarding the diverse academic programs offered at SHGC, including B.Com., B.Sc., BCA, BBA, M.Com., M.Sc., and B.Ed.
