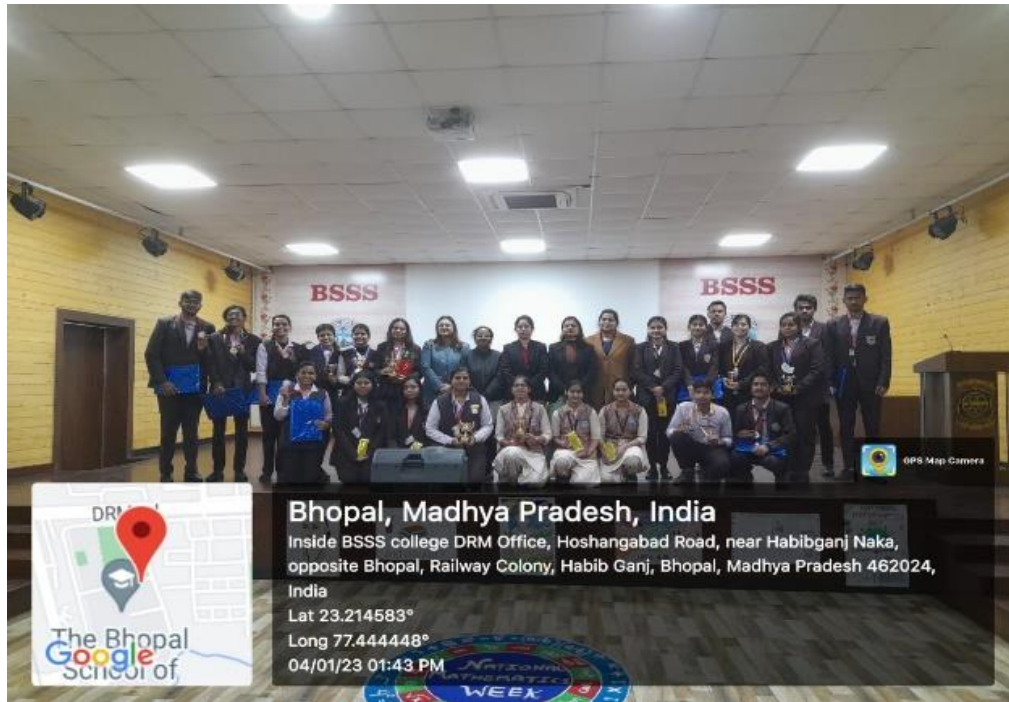
**Monthly Report

Guest Lecture on IPA and Phonetic Symbols.



- On 4th January, 2023, Wednesday, Department of Language had organized a Guest Lecture on IPA and Phonetic Symbols. The objective behind organizing this guest lecture was to improve the phonetic skills of the students so that they can understand the pronunciation and how the speech sounds are organized. The subject expert was Ms. Fatima Khan, IPA expert and English Language Trainer.
- Dr. Dalima Parwani, Principal said that IPA is easy to read with relatively little training and an excellent learning tool for pronunciation.
- The Subject Expert, Ms. Fatima Khan introduced the students to phonetics. She explained in detail the phonetic chart and vowel sounds. She provided the hands-on practice sheets to students. She elaborated on syllables, monophthongs and diphthongs. She further highlighted on Intonation, Cadence, Articulation, elocution and Lexical words. She helped the students to learn the phonetic spelling by giving examples.
- The concluding remarks were shared by Dr. Neha Gupta, Head, Department of Language. The Management appreciated the commendable efforts of the Department of Language and extended best wishes for future endeavours.

On Day 3, Prof. Reeta Budhani explained cross linking and real time practice in Digital Marketing.
- A competition was also organized on Website Designing and the best three websites were awarded with certificates and prizes.

- On 9th January 2023, Women Cell in joint collaboration with NSS and Department of Chemistry had organized a Seminar as per the guidelines of UGC on **Striving Towards Construction of Gender-Neutral World**. The Resource Person was Ms. Kumud Singh, Founder, Sarokar NGO.
- India's PM Modiji is constantly stressing that respect for women is an important pillar of India's growth and emphasized the need to extend support to the country's 'Nari Shakti' to ensure Swift progress and added that gender equality starts from family as it is the foundation for building unity and solidarity in the society. Keeping this viewpoint in mind the Women Cell had organized this seminar.
- The Chairperson of Women Cell and Principal of SHGC, Dr. Dalima Parwani talking about the working of Women Cell said that gender sensitization is important but both the genders play a pivotal role. She explained that sometimes we want something but are denied due to gender is actually sensitization. She further added that women have special sense and power of premonition of danger. She consoled the students to face any danger with grace and dignity.
- Ms. Kumud Singh said that the mindset of people about gender should change. She quoted the example of Tribal women of India and said that these women enjoy a higher status within their communities as compared to the rest of the women. She emphasized that gender neutrality is a progressive approach and by following few steps it can be achieved viz., acknowledging the problem or the issue, fostering open discourse and establishing formal support. She also shared the basic difference between gender equality and gender neutrality.
- In the end as per the guidelines of UGC, the students and faculties pledged as Gender Champions who would facilitate an enabling environment in the institution

Youth Employment Program Commenced at SHGC



- From 9th January, 2023 onwards 90 hours Youth Employment Program had commenced by Training and Placement Cell of Saint Hirdaram Girls College, Bhopal in joint collaboration with TCS. - The module for seven days was planned, according to which, DNA isolation methods were practically demonstrated by SDS extraction and Ethanol Precipitation method. Gel Electrophoresis, Restriction Digestion, Polymerase chain reaction and transformation technique was elaborated through hands on protocols. ELISA, Radial Immuno Diffusion, Immunoelectrophoresis, Blood grouping like immunological techniques were also performed under the guidance of Prof. Shazia Khan, Head, Department of Biotechnology and Dr. Divya Patel, Assistant professor of Biotechnology. In the concluding session to check the knowledge gained by the students, a test was conducted on the entire training program.
- Dr. Dalima Parwani, Principal congratulated the coordinator Prof. Shazia Khan for successfully completing the training program and motivated the students to acquire more and more hands in practical skills to achieve success in their careers.
