Seven Days Training Program



- On 13th December, 2022, Tuesday, Department of Biotechnology, Sant Hirdaram Girls College, Bhopal had organized Seven Days Training Program on **Advanced Molecular Biology and Immunology Technologies** to impart skill-based learning and enhancing the practical skills of the students. 25 students from four different institutions participated in the program viz., Babulal Gaur Government PG College, BHEL, Government Mahatma Gandhi Memorial College, Itarsi, Mittal Institute of Technology, Bhopal and Sant Hirdaram Girls College, Bhopal.
- The module for seven days was planned, according to which, on Day 1, DNA isolation methods were practically demonstrated by SDS extraction and Ethanol Precipitation method. On Day 2, Plasmid isolation experiment was explained. On Day 3, PowerPoint presentation on Gel Electrophoresis technique was elaborated through ELISA protocol. On Day 4, Sophisticated molecular biology techniques which is PCR and restriction digestion and radial immuno diffusion was described. On Day 5, students were asked to prepare competent cells and perform quantitative analysis of DNA by DPA method. On Day 6, the students were requested to prepare report on the training program. On the last Day, under the guidance of Prof. Shazia Khan, Head, Department of Biotechnology and Dr. Divya Patel, Assistant professor of Biotechnology illustrated blood grouping and haemin crystal formation practical. In the concluding session to check the knowledge gained by the students, a test was conducted on the entire training program.
- Dr. Dalima Parwani, Principal congratulated the coordinator Prof. Shazia Khan for successfully completing the training program and motivated the students to acquire more and more hands in practical skills to achieve success in their careers. He also quoted Indian polymath Chanakya who said that a soldier dies in the battlefield but his actual death occurs only when the country forgets the contributions and sacrifices of their soldiers.

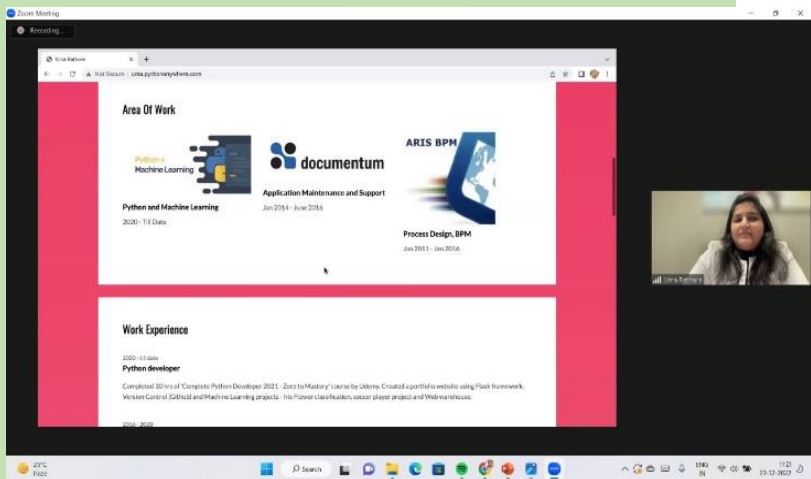
International Webinar
