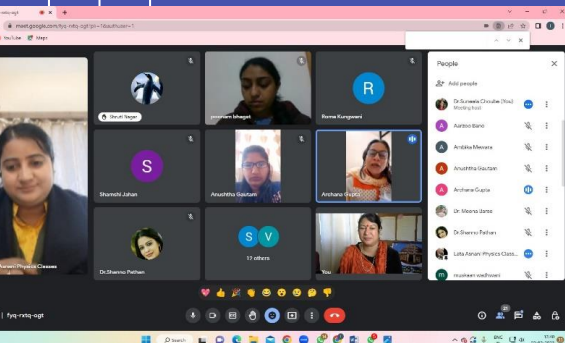

As we approach the end of the academic session, it’s a good idea to prepare for exams early by bettering the exam writing skills.

Dr. Dalima Parwani Principal, SHGC explained on exam writing skills & techniques which are used by learners to cope better while writing an exam, so that learners can achieve better results in the exams and having these writing skills learners will not be panic during the exam, they will feel more prepared & confident in their exams.

Ms. Sharanjit Kaur, explained about the format to write answers like sections of Question paper, Question numbers should be mentioned clearly on the top of the page, writing the answers should be in sequence –Introduction, definitions, main features in points, use of different types of diagrams, use of small paragraphs & Conclusion, also timings should be divided according to marks to write the answers and maintain consistency in handwriting during the whole examination.

Ms. Lata Asnani, elaborated that, read instructions carefully before writing the exam and answers should be in relevant key points or in bullet points related with the present scenario, go for content thoroughly before the examination by revising the content again & again. Always avoid distraction and stress during the exam.

The session imbued with intellectual suggestion & creative ideas to write the answers, ended with concluding remarks & distribution of ‘E’ Certificates. Overall, the session was very informative and provided the enormous knowledge to the participants.

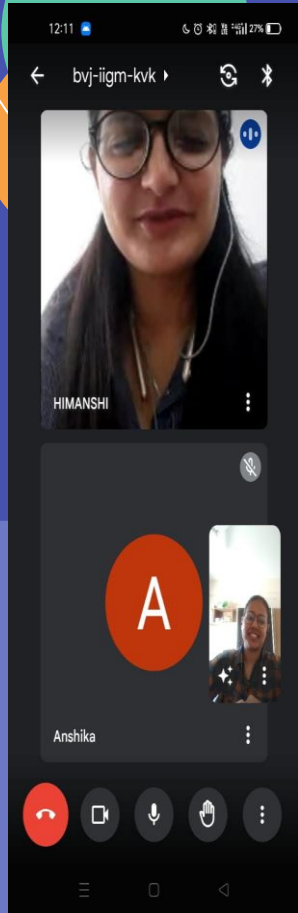


Virtual Campus Drive
