day, 7th July, 2022




Dr Dalima Parwani, Principal heartily welcomed everyone by initiating her speech to convey the importance of moral values in life and explained how self – retrospection is required.


The new comers highly appreciated the Orientation programme as it was very valuable and informative giving an insight into the students' expectations.


Capacity Building Program
