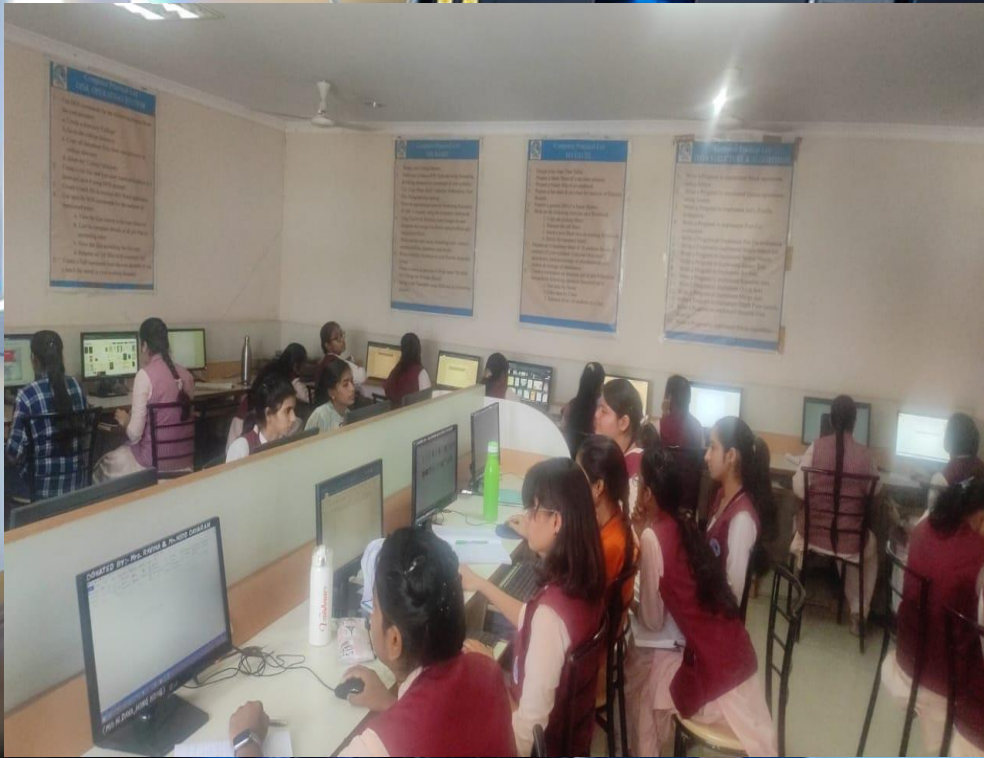

The exam is conducted at **three different levels as per the CA courses**. For being certified as a Chartered Accountant, candidates have to clear all the course levels. **The exam comprises of following papers:**

CA **Foundation** course examination (four papers)

CA **Intermediate** examination (eight papers)

CA **Final** examination (eight paper)

Intermediate and Final CA Examination May 2023, has been conducted smoothly at Sant Hirdaram Girls College, Bhopal. The exam included MCQ's as well as descriptive type questions. The question papers were kept in the safe custody of Bank of Baroda, Malviya Nagar, Bhopal by ICAI. Every day on the date of Exam, as per the Code allotted, the question papers were distributed to the respective examination centres in the presence of Observers appointed by ICAI and Chief Invigilator of the institution. Dr. Suneela Choube, Asst. Prof. & HOD, Education has been assigned as Chief Invigilator under the supervision and guidance of the Principal, Dr. Dalima Parwani. Every day, full time Observers were deputed by ICAI to monitor the vigilance of the exam. All the teaching and non-teaching Staff members worked effectively and efficiently in the overall interest of CA Student's community.

The observers appreciated the working style of the exam functionaries and the abled guidance of the higher authorities. CA Foundation Examination has been scheduled from 24<sup>th</sup> June onwards and our institution has been again earmarked to conduct the exam.

# MPPSC Examination, 2022

With the blessings of Santji and inspirations of Shradhhey Siddh Bhauji, it's a matter of great pride that the College has been earmarked to conduct the highly prestigious exam held in the state to appoint candidates to the gazette posts i.e., State Service Preliminary Examination-2022 (MPPSC) for the very first time. It is one of the most popular exams among aspirants belonging to the state of Madhya Pradesh. The selection for this exam is done through Prelims, Mains, and Interviews.

The Exam was scheduled on 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2023 (Sunday) and was conducted smoothly in 2 Shifts (First Session-Paper I General Studies from 10 am to 12 Noon & Second Session-Paper II General Aptitude Test from 2.15 pm to 4.15 pm).

Dr. Jeetendra Kumar Parmar was assigned as Observer for our examination centre 25/42. A briefing session was scheduled one day prior to the examination on 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2023. All the Govt. Invigilators appointed by PSC along with SHGC exam functionaries attended the briefing. 600 students were allotted to our Center. Students from all over India appeared in the exam at our center. The examination confidential material was received in time by the Govt. officials. One CS (Dr. Dalima Parwani), One Examination Controller (Shri Brijesh Mishra), Three ACS (Dr. Suneela Choube, Dr. Meenu Tahilyani & Ms. Reeta Budhani), 4 Asst, Invigilators (Dr. Meena Barse, Ms. Tushita Pardasani, Ms. Shalini Motwani & Ms. Manju Chhugani), and almost 50 invigilators (Govt. & Host Institution) along with clerical, frisking and supporting staff were appointed as per the guidelines of MPPSC. No area was left unattended during the complete tenure of the exam. The exam comprised of lot many protocols and proceedings, which were followed vigilantly.

## Workshop on “Communicating with Confidence, CWC”



Home visits can establish positive contact and communication with school students and their respective families that help to enhance the social, personal and emotional development of all learners. Looking upon such need and to build good relations with the schools' students, home visits were organized by the admission team of the college.

All faculties of the college are conducting home visits of class XII students on regular basis. The visit should focus on building a relationship, extending support, actively listening to students and their parents' concerns and insights.

During the visit, Students were briefed about the various facilities and courses offered by the college. Faculties introduced them to various courses of science, commerce and Computer Science as the basics and then they explained them the sea of opportunities in the outer world. They also encouraged them on choosing the field they are interested in rather than allowing somebody else to govern it. They were informed about how to plan their career after 12th class. They were also briefed that "How choosing the correct college is the key to fulfill the dreams".

The various areas of Bhopal are covered like Gandhi Nagar, Bairagarh, DIG, Ashoka Garden, Ayodhya Bypass, Old City, Nehru Nagar, Kolar, Lalghati etc. Other than Bhopal cities/towns/villages are visited like Sehore, Kurawar, Mugaliya Hat, Kurana, Hoshangabad, Vidisha, Kala Pipal, Itarsi, Jarkheda, Ashta, etc. Approximately 500-600 home visits were conducted.

In addition to home visits, counselling sessions were also provided in college for the students who are visiting college for admission enquiry.

To promote talented students to perform their best in their respective educational domains and shine bright in the future, college has also introduced meritorious scholarship scheme. It is based entirely on student's merit in their academics. The primary objective of this scholarship is to reward girl students who are academically good and allow them to pursue their education in various courses at graduate and post graduate level. Students who have scored 71% to 80% will be given 10% discount, 81% to 90% will be entitled for 20% discount, 91% to 95% will get 25% discount and more than 95% will get 30% discount. This would also encourage the meritorious students of economically weaker background to pursue quality higher education without having to worry about the finances.

Online Admissions of First year students have been started from 25<sup>th</sup> July 2023. All the procedures and activities regarding admission will be conducted and will be accorded in strict adherence to the "Admission and Counseling Schedule" provided by Madhya Pradesh Higher Education Guidelines 2023.
