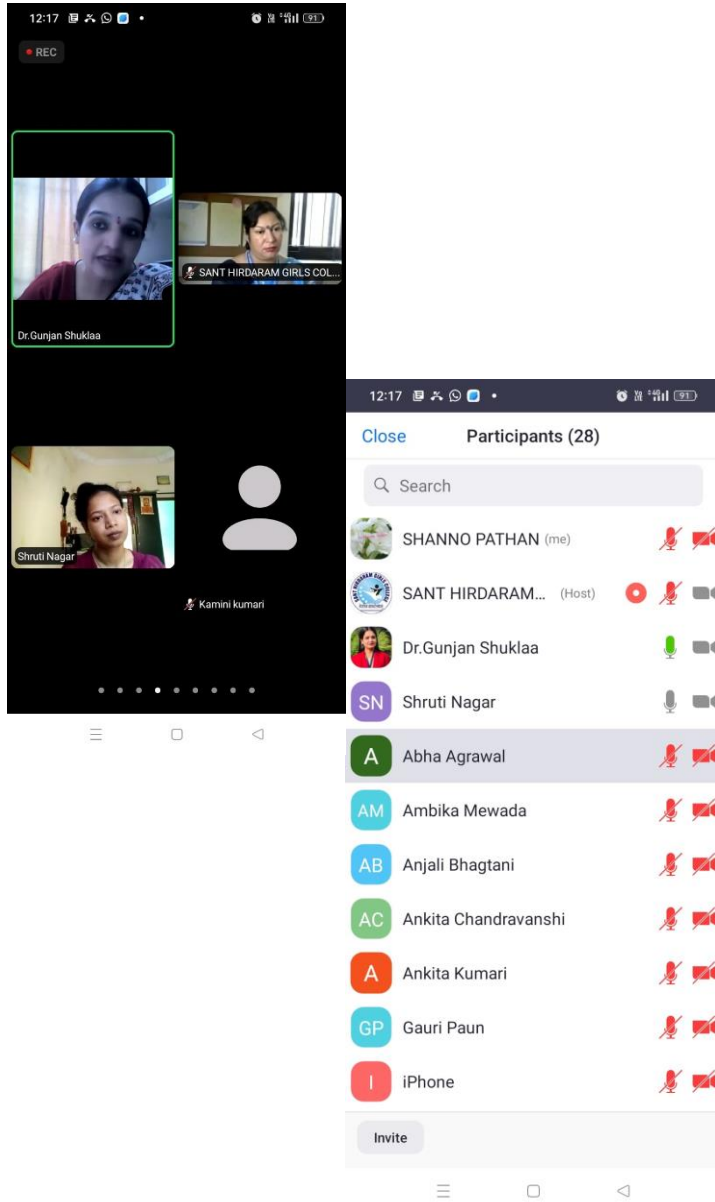

- The session was very informative & provided the Participants with enormous knowledge on Edupreneur & students learnt a lot from this.

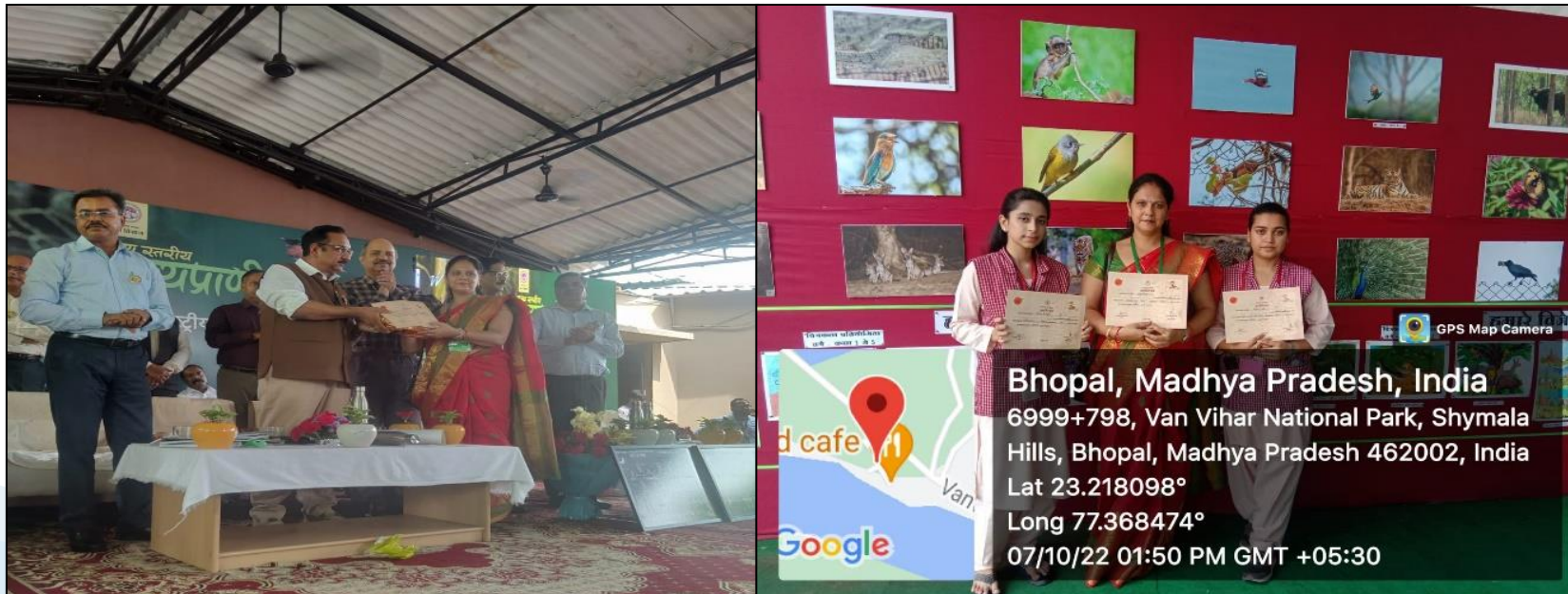
The Euphoria of Garba in SHGC

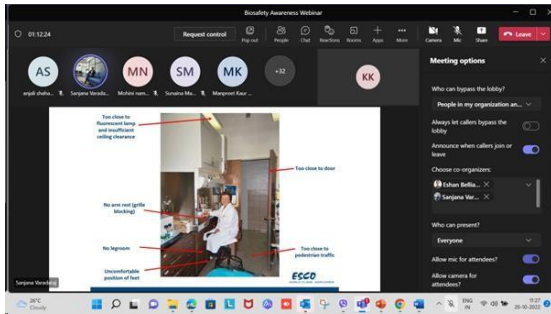




Session on “Role of BIS and Its Activities” & Industrial Visit to “Ozone Aqua Pvt. Ltd.”

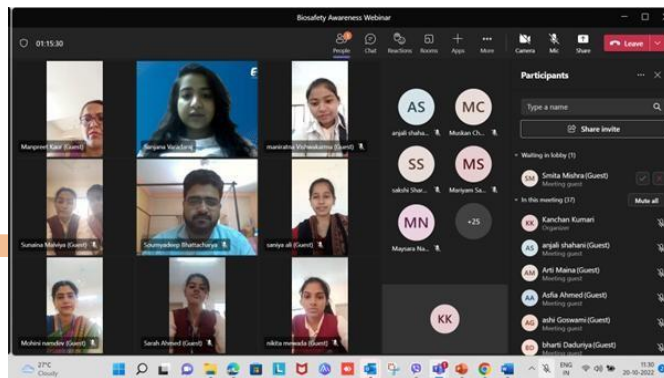

National Unity Day Celebrated in SHGC

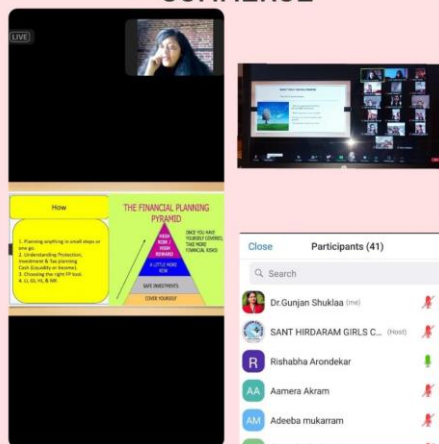
