## Students participated in the Workshop on Climate Clock Assembly



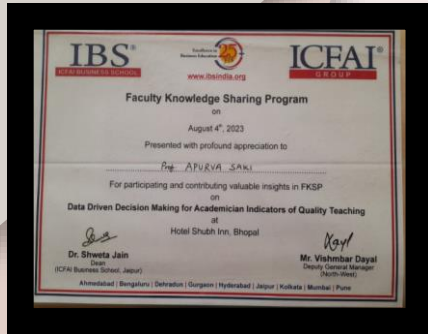

# Data Driven Decision Making for Academician Indicators of Quality Teaching

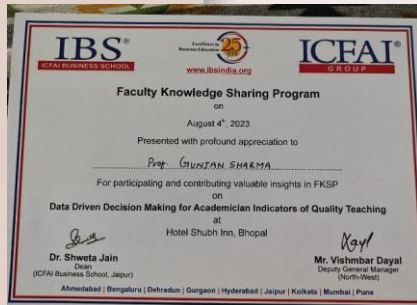




## Faculty Achievement – Dr. Geeta Guwalani
