The Principal, Dr. Dalima Parwani while congratulating on this achievement, said that the college provides a platform to the students as well as the teachers so that their skills can develop.

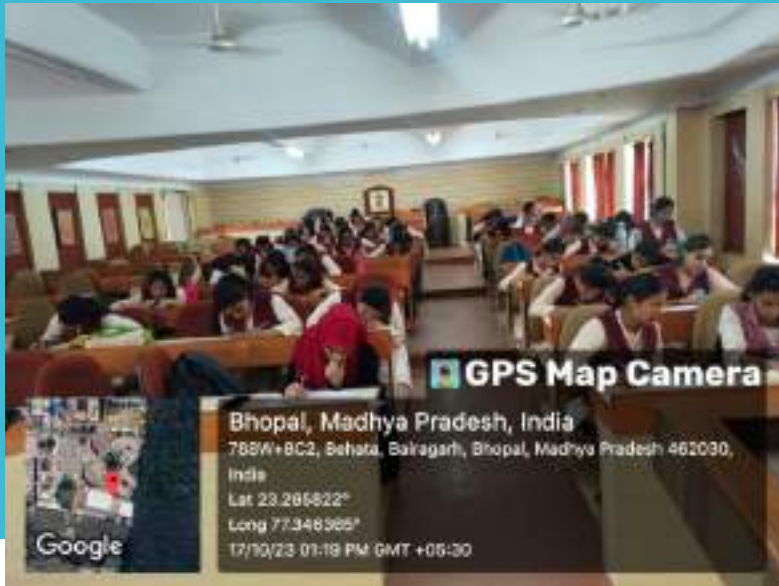
## Sanskriti Gyan Pariksha Organized
