

- 5. Craft a compelling narrative: skillfully narrating one's professional journey to engage interviewers.
- 6. Leverage knowledge: demonstrating the application of knowledge and expertise relevant to the job.

Happiness = harmony & unhappiness = disharmony. We were also asked to find out the answers of the following questions:

Is it important for human being to understand?

What does human being need to understand?

Can every human being understand?

What is the process of understanding?

The day 1 ended with the conclusion that human society consists of right understanding and right feeling in every individual, prosperity in every family, fearlessness in the society and co-existence in nature. Inhumane society is based on the assumption that money is everything, dominated by terrorism and war and exploitation of environment by resource depletion and pollution.

Day 1 ended with a positive learning and a change in outlook.

#### FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM ON UNIVERSAL HUMAN VALUES

**DAY 2:** we were given a brief review of content discussed on day -1 with the view of understanding of the topics of the previous day. As we were taught about the state of being happy= harmony. The next question which was asked was all about the continuity of being happy at all the levels of being i.E., Harmony in the human being, harmony in the family, harmony in the nature which we can analyze through a method of self-exploration. The speaker stated the difference between the self and body on the basis of need, time, quantity, fulfillment, activity and response. The speaker also taught us about knowing, assuming, recognizing and fulfilling which is on complete basis. We were asked to find out the answers of the following questions:

Are we keeping ourselves happy?

Is happiness a continuous process?

Are we involved in the process of self-exploration?

Day 2 ended with the conclusion of finding out ways for being happy, involving ourselves in the process of self-exploration, keeping our desires, thoughts and expectations towards our sources of motivation.

Day 3: we were given a brief review of content discussed on day -2 with the view of understanding of the topics of the previous day. We were asked to find out "how much physical facility is required in our family; how much physical facility is available?" We should have right understanding of harmony in the family- trust, respect, affection, care, guidance, reverence, glory, gratitude, love. We should have right understanding within ourselves for right understanding harmony at all levels of being (human being, family, society, nature/existence). We should have right understanding of program for harmony in the body- 1. Intake and daily routine (lifestyle), 2. Labour and exercise, 3. Postures for regulating internal & external body organs and regulated breathing, 4. Medicine and treatment. We were also asked to find out the answers of the following questions:

To understand human being as self and body.

To understand knowing, assuming and recognizing and accepting.

To understand source of motivations for our desires - its implications.

To understand source harmony of the self with the body.

The day 3 followed question/ answers session and feedback session. The day 3 ended with the conclusion continuous happiness is possible only if: we can understand harmony and live in harmony and there is a provision in nature/existence for understanding harmony and living in harmony.

# INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO LM BAKERS (PARLE-G)



Professor akansha arora, the head of the commerce department, underscored the substantial advantages this hands-on experience would provide in molding the students' future.




### **FACULTY ACHIEVEMENT**
