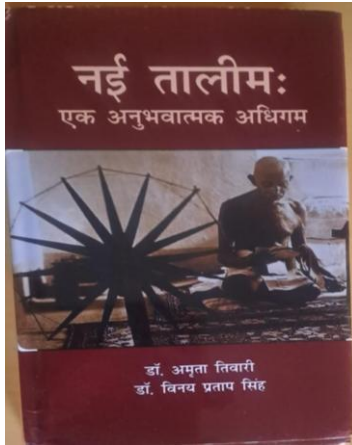

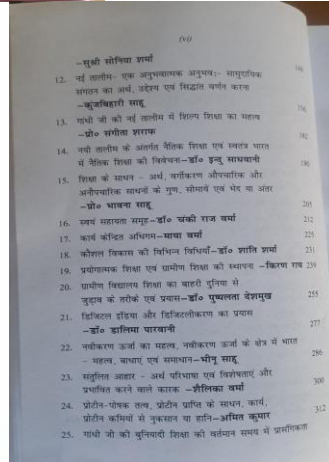
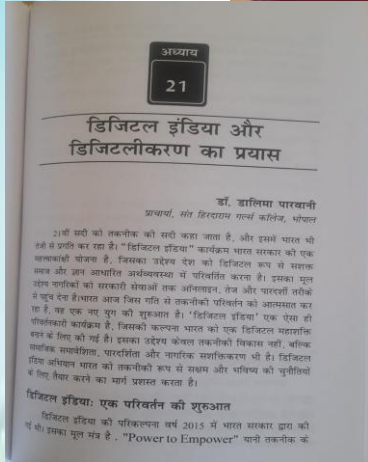

Tuesday to Monday, 9th to 15th December, 2025

A seven-day Mushroom Cultivation Training Programme successfully conducted

The Department of Biotechnology, Sant Hirdaram Girls College, Bhopal, in collaboration with the Madhya Pradesh Council of Science and Technology (MPCST), Bhopal, successfully organized certificate course cum hands-on training program on Science for Socio-Economic Development through Mushroom Cultivation: skill and startup potential from 9 December 2025 to 15 December 2025. The primary objective of the programme was to promote skill development, entrepreneurship, and hands-on scientific knowledge among students.

On the first day, Dr. Mukul Kumar (Scientist, Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Raisen) delivered an expert lecture on the importance of mushrooms, major cultivated species, nutritional value, market potential, and scientific cultivation practices. He also demonstrated the substrate material sterilization process through a live practical session.

On the second day, Ms. Sandhya Sahu (Founder, Green Agro Solutions, Mandideep) conducted an intensive practical training session on oyster mushroom cultivation. She demonstrated substrate filling, layering techniques, hygiene standards, and moisture management through live demonstrations.

On the third day, Dr. Divya Patel conducted a session on how to write an effective training report. This was followed by a career guidance session by Dr. Shazia Khan, who highlighted career opportunities in biotechnology, national and international competitive examinations, and internship programmes offered by IISERs and IISc. Students also practiced bag filling during this session.

On the fourth and fifth days, Dr. Ashish Shrivastava (Agricultural Scientist, College of Agriculture, Ganjbasoda) delivered detailed lectures on spawn preparation, precautionary measures, harvesting techniques, marketing strategies, and the complete cultivation process of button mushroom. Students performed practical exercises on spawn bag preparation and aseptic techniques.

Subsequently, the participants were taken on an educational field visit to Sumitra Farms, Tumda under the guidance of Ms. Megha Khare (Assistant Professor, Agriculture Department, RKDF University) where they closely observed various agricultural activities and the commercial-scale mushroom production system. This visit proved highly beneficial in familiarizing students with real-life business models and entrepreneurship management.
